Our 3rd graders will parade around the school on the last day at 1:30 p.m. Congrats on a **JOB WELL DONE!** We will miss you!!!

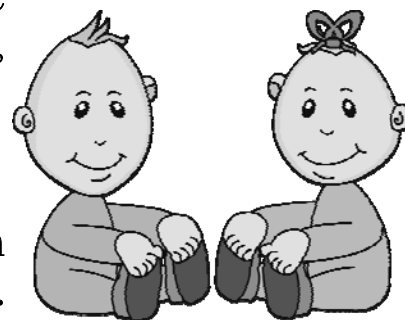
Kindergarten Graduation
