PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

SOME IMPORTANT INFORMATION

<u>DOORS LOCKED</u>: After the tardy bell rings each day at 8:40 a.m., ALL doors, including the front doors to the office, are locked. To obtain entrance into the building, please "call" using the keypad to the right of the front doors. This will alert the office that someone is waiting to be let into the building. The office can see who is there, ask questions, etc.



STUDENT FEES: All students K-12 will be charged a student fee of \$40 again this year to help offset some of our expenditures. Please send check or money order made payable to Newton Falls Elementary School no later than Friday, January 19.

INTERIMS: These reports will be sent home with students **TODAY**.

CHANGE OF CLOTHES - It is very important that EVERY STUDENT have a change of clothes kept in their locker. (Spilled drinks, mud or water from the playground, bathroom accidents, bloody nose, etc.) It is easier and more comfortable for the student if they have their own items to change into.

PICTURE RETAKE DAY

ATTENDANCE REMINDERS

If your child is absent...

1—**CALL** the school (330-872-5225) the morning of the absence to report your child off and give the reason for the absence.

2—Send a **NOTE** to the school the day your child returns. The note must state why the student was absent, the date of the absence, and include the parent/guardian's signature.

All absences are designated as unexcused, unless an excuse is provided within the 48 hour allocated time period.

If your child is absent due to a doctor/dentist appointment, be sure to **get an excuse while at the appointment** and turn it into the office the following day. If the doctor/dentist needs to fax an excuse, our fax number is 330-872-0228.

A doctor's excuse verifying the illness may be required after a child is called off for personal illness 5 times in a grading period or 10 times for the entire school year. If your child sees a doctor, please be sure to get an excuse from the doctor's office.

If your child is tardy, they must be signed in by an adult. Students may accumulate a maximum of 10 tardies in a semester. With the 11th tardy, the student and/or parent will be required to attend a truancy intervention program.

Please keep in mind that our handbook states that the building administrator must receive a written request **two to five days** prior to a student going on vacation for vacation to be an excused absence.
