Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is an approach to teaching and supporting positive behaviors and meeting the needs of ALL students. This school-wide approach to behavior focuses on building a safe and positive environment in which all students can learn. The foundation of PBIS at Newton Falls Elementary/Middle School is the following building-wide expectation

Be Respectful

Be Responsible

Be Safe

Be a Learner
