Ohio State AIR Tests:

Beginning on April 7th, students in grades 3-5 will begin taking the state AIR tests. Students in these grades will take an exam in ELA (English Language Arts) and Math with fifth grade students also taking a Science exam. Each academic area will be evaluated with two different tests.

Our teachers have been working very hard to ensure that our students are prepared by presenting lessons that meet grade level standards, but we also need your help.

Here are a few things that you can do at home:

- 1) Have your child read every night at home and ask them questions about the text
