The Kindergarten Transition Fair is organized by the Trumbull County Kindergarten Transition Committee whose members represent over a dozen community businesses and organizations.

THE TRUMBULL COUNTY SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL KINDERGARTEN READINESS PROGRAM:

- Helps prepare children and families for kindergarten
- Focuses on the social and emotional needs of children and their families
- Builds connections between the child, family, school, and community
- Promotes a developmental approach to kindergarten transition
- Forms a network of social, educational, and informational links to build connections



The 2019 Kindergarten Transition Fair was a GREAT SUCCESS!

- Over 800 people attended the event, including 225 incoming Kindergarteners. Families in attendance were from 21 Trumbull County School districts.
- 100% of participants said that they would recommend the event to another parent.
- 38 community partners provided support.



Educators from 19 Trumbull County schools were present to meet incoming kindergarteners and answer families' questions about kindergarten readiness and registration.

Based upon the Social and Emotional Kindergarten Readiness model, children and their families were able to visit the following interactive stations, aligned with the Ohio Early Learning Standards:
