KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Registration for children entering the Newton Falls Exempted Village School District for the 19-20 school year will be held on the following dates and times:

February 14, 2019 from 3:30-8:00 p.m. and
March 11-15, 2019 from 9:00-11:00 a.m. & 12:30-2:30 p.m.

You do NOT need an appointment, but **please only come during these times.** It is not necessary to bring your child at this time. **To be eligible for kindergarten, your child must be 5 years of age by August 1, 2019.** Upon registering, you will be given an appointment to bring your child to the school in the Spring for screening.

You will need to bring the following items with you when registering:

- Your child's legal birth certificate
- Immunization records
- Child's Social Security Card
- Proof of residency
- Custody papers (if applicable)

(Must be: current utility bill-not cell phone, apartment rental agreement/mortgage payment receipt, or driver's registration-not license)
