Now that the year is already halfway over, I wanted to bring to your attention some important dates and exciting events in the new year. First, Tuesday, March 17, 2020, is an early election day for our state. Locally, the Newton Falls Exempted Village School District will have two renewal levies on the ballot. These are renewal levies that will not increase your taxes. They are not new levies. The school district counts on both of these levies for our day-to-day operations. One levy is for 6 mills and the other levy is for 4.7 mills. The 6 mill levy was originated in 1991 and generates \$739,483 for our school district. The 4.7 mill levy originated in 2015 and it generates \$585,011 for the Newton Falls Exempted Village School District. These levies are very important to our school district, and they are the only operating levies we have passed since 1991. If you have any questions concerning the renewal levies, feel free to attend the regularly scheduled Board meeting at 6:00 p.m., on Thursday, February 20, located in the Boardroom. We will also have a levy informational meeting on Saturday, February 22, at 9:00 a.m., in the high school library. As always, feel free to call me or set up an appointment with me at 330-872-5445.
