



2020 OH PBIS Recognition Award Winner Press Release

Newton Falls Junior High & High School has been recognized for their success with Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS). PBIS involves teaching students expected behaviors in a consistent and positive way, modeling and acknowledging those behaviors, and helping all students meet expectations and be successful. PBIS has been shown to improve student achievement, student behavior, and school climate. In 2015, Ohio PBIS Network first recognized schools who were model examples of strong PBIS. In 2020, Newton Falls Junior High & High School applied and earned the Bronze level. They are one of 307 (29 for Gold, 63 for Silver, 215 for Bronze) award winning schools to be recognized at any of the levels Gold, Silver, or Bronze. Newton Falls Junior High & High School will be honored at the 2020 Ohio PBIS Showcase in conjunction with the Ohio Leadership Advisory Council (OLAC) virtual conference on December 15, 2020.
